East Riding of Yorkshire Council Social Care Leadership



East Riding of Yorkshire Council's Social Care Management Team was supported by the ESIF TAP to develop an application for ESF funding to deliver master class training sessions, a feedback and evaluation day and a number of supported distance learning sessions to lower and middle management in adult social care.

ESIF TAP assisted the organisation to apply for ESF support through providing:

- A Calls Launch (26/05/16) to inform organisations of funding opportunities/ help available**
- Four sessions of 1:1 support from an ESF specialist from the TAP team to Outline Application**
- Three sessions of 1:1 support from an ESF specialist from the TAP team to Full Application**

The outline application was **approved** on the 26 September 2016 and the full application on the 20 April 2017. The East Riding of Yorkshire Council was awarded **£60,000** to deliver the project.

The project will enhance staff leadership skills and thus improve the staff culture, business performance and raise the standards across the adult care sector, ultimately improving individual competencies and improving the care to people they are responsible for.
